- 2. Helping students complete scholarship applications
- 3. Helping students complete applications for internship and employment opportunities; and
- 4. Evaluating statistical employment data of current and former CPS students to ensure CPS programs are continually improving to ensure students are college and career ready.

It is important that the high school counselor have access to your social security number to support their efforts in securing opportunities for financial assistance, scholarships and/or employment. We therefore ask that you complete and sign the form below.

Under Illinois' Identity Protection Act and the CPS Social Security Number Protection Policy, CPS is required to protect the confidentiality of student social security numbers. Accordingly, CPS has put in place security measures to protect and strictly prohibit social security numbers from unauthorized disclosure.

We believe that the collection and use of social security numbers for the reasons stated above is worthwhile and supports a student's effective transition to college or career.
